### Proposed Scope of Work

### Operational Strategy

## **Communication and Emergency Response**

### **COMMUNICATION**

One of the major contributors to the efficiency of our security guard program is effective communication. We achieve this by the provision of either mobile handset and radio walkie talkies to enable the guards to communicate with each other and with our mobile patrol units and operations headquarters. These communication network:

- Makes it possible for beat to receive instructions and information in real time,
- Enables the beat to contact the mobile response vehicle and our patrol officers.
- Enables the security officers to contact each other at any time particularly in the case of an emergency on the premises,
- Enables the operations headquarter to contact any guard post to render real time help were necessary.
- Helps the company to contact the client directly to ensure that he/she is getting value for our services
- Enables the customer relationship department to receive complaints and forward appropriately to their respective department.

## **Emergency Response Plan**

Our emergency response plan is hinged on two approaches namely; the **Internal Emergency Response** and the **External Emergency Response**.

### **Internal Emergency Response**

The internal response plan has a team comprised of the General Manager, Operations Manager and Zonal Coordinators who are equipped with a standby Operational Vehicle and Motor Bikes to respond to emergencies as at when they happen.

### **External Emergency Response**

Our external emergency response plan is coordinated by our General Manager who liaises with personnel from the Police, Air force, Army, Navy, Civil Defence (NSCDC), the Fire Service Department and the community vigilante for quick response and assistance in the case of an emergency.

The emergency response is coordinated through our **Call Centres** thereby ensuring a quick and timely response to distress calls. We also focus on developing strong relationships with nearby police commands and mobile patrol units.
